## TRINITY ICONOGRAPHY INSTITUTE CLASS SCHEDULE: 2015 - 2016

Trinity Episcopal Cathedral is pleased to announce the following schedule for Iconography Classes at Trinity Iconography Institute.

**Father Jon Buffington,** a Chaldean Catholic priest and **Master Iconographer**, will teach all classes, which are conducted in relative silence as a spiritual journey, always starting with group prayer. Classes are taught using the traditional egg tempera medium; are open to all Christians of any tradition <u>over the age of 18</u> and are limited to a maximum of 10 students.

Please note that the Summer's second class will be for advanced students only.

NOTE: If the Director and Instructor determine that insufficient numbers of students have Registered for a specific class, that class may be canceled.

<u>SPRING CLASS:</u> Every Monday beginning February **16, 2015** and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. (Ends May 11, 2015) <u>Register by January 18, 2015</u>

<u>SUMMER CLASS #1:</u> Beginning **Monday**, **August 3**, **2015** and running for one week. Classes begin at 8.30 am and will recess daily at 4.30 pm. A lunch period of 1 hour is taken. Students may bring lunch or order from a no-host deli menu. Deli lunches will be delivered to the Cathedral; soft drinks & refreshments will be provided. **Register by July 5**, **2015** 

<u>SUMMER CLASS #2:</u> Beginning **Monday, August 17, 2015** and running for one week. This class is for students who have previously taken at least one other approved class in iconography, using egg-tempera. Advanced subjects to be taught will be announced later. All other information is as above.

<u>Register by July 17, 2015</u>

FALL CLASS: Every Monday beginning October 19, 2015 and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. (Ends Jan 11, 2016)

Register by September 20, 2015

SPRING CLASS: Every Monday beginning February 1, 2016 and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. (Ends April 25, 2016)

Register by January 1, 2016

<u>SUMMER CLASS #1:</u> Beginning **Monday, August 8, 2016** and running for one week. Classes begin at 8.30 am and will recess daily at 4.30 pm. A lunch period of 1 hour is taken. Students may bring lunch or order from a no-host delimenu. Deli lunches will be delivered to the Cathedral; soft drinks & refreshments will be provided. <u>Register by July 8, 2016</u>

<u>SUMMER CLASS #2:</u> Beginning **Monday**, **August 22**, **2016** and running for one week. This class is for students who have previously taken at least one other approved class in iconography, using egg-tempera. Advanced subjects to be taught will be announced later. All other information is as above.

<u>Register by July 22, 2016</u>

<u>FALL CLASS:</u> Every Monday beginning **September 19, 2016** and running for 12 weeks. Classes begin at 6.30 pm and continue until 9 pm each evening. (Ends December 5, 2016) **Register by August 19, 2016** 

<u>FEES:</u> Tuition fees for all **2015** classes are a total of \$350, which includes a non-refundable \$50 Administrative fee. Fees for 2016 will be announced later. Unless having purchased one for a prior egg tempera class, students will purchase a pigments kit from the Institute that will contain all the dry pigments needed for the class, at a cost of approximately \$50.00, depending on the pigments' wholesale costs. Costs of any other supplies needed are additional.

**LOCATION:** All classes are held in Bishop Scott room, in the lower part of Trinity Episcopal Cathedral's Commons. Trinity Episcopal Cathedral is located at 147 NW 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Portland, Oregon (corner of NW 19<sup>th</sup> and Everett Street.)

<u>PARKING:</u> Trinity owns three parking lots adjacent to the Cathedral; one directly in front, across NW 19<sup>th</sup>; one immediately beside the Cathedral to the South on NW 19<sup>th</sup> and one behind the Cathedral campus on NW Trinity Place. No parking passes are needed <u>except on Summer Thursday daytimes and on all Providence Park game nights</u>. Handicapped parking spaces or assistance with Cathedral access are available upon request.

REGISTRATION: Registration for all classes is on a "first-come-first served" basis. Tuition fees must be paid in full and a Registration Form (see the accompanying form below) submitted - which must be received by the specified Registration date, before a student is considered Registered.
